JULY 8 – “The Plot Against Harry”

A dour Jewish mobster, Harry Plotnick (Martin Priest) is finally released from prison after doing time for two decades. Returning to a very different world, Harry tries to ease back into his criminal ways on his old turf, but it soon becomes clear that he is thoroughly outmoded. When he encounters his ex-wife, Kay (Maxine Woods), and the now-adult daughters that he doesn't even know, he decides to clean up his act. Can Harry really turn over a new leaf?

July 15 – “The Heartbreak Kid”

After a short fling with a beautiful woman named Lila (Malin Akerman), and at the urging of his friends and family, Eddie (Ben Stiller) proposes marriage. But Eddie didn't realize that Lila is a shrew, and she reveals her true nature during their honeymoon. He then meets Miranda (Michelle Monaghan), and is convinced she is his soul mate. Eddie sets out to woo Miranda and extricate himself from his wife's claws.

July 22 – “I’m Not Rappaport”

Radical 81-year-old Nat Moyer (Walter Matthau) spends most of his time talking and arguing with his old friend Midge Carter (Ossie Davis) on a bench in Central Park. When Midge's job as a superintendent is threatened by the conversion of the apartment building, where he works, into a co-op, Nat impersonates a lawyer to help him out -- one of many disguises he assumes in his quest for social justice. Nat's antics worry his daughter, Clara (Amy Irving), who wants him to enter a nursing home.

July 29 – “Keeping Up With The Steins”

Benjamin Fiedler (Daryl Sabara) has a lot to be nervous about; his bar mitzvah is fast approaching, and his parents (Jeremy Piven, Jami Gertz) are caught up in plans to make his party even more lavish than the one the Steins threw for their son. Amid his family's debate over whether to invite an estranged grandfather (Garry Marshall), the youth solves the problem by arranging for Grandpa to arrive two weeks early.
